First, they came to the playground.






The Mighty Robot pushed Ricky

Then Ricky tried to push his Robot on the swing set.


“This is not fun,” said Ricky.



Next, Ricky and his Robot flew to the amusement park.


Ricky got on the Ferris wheel.

“This is fun!” said Ricky.




Then Ricky's Mighty Robot got on the Ferris wheel.

“This is not fun,” said Ricky.




Finally, Ricky and his Mighty Robot went to the swimming pool. Ricky did a perfect swan dive. "That was fun!" said Ricky.
