First, they came to the playground.



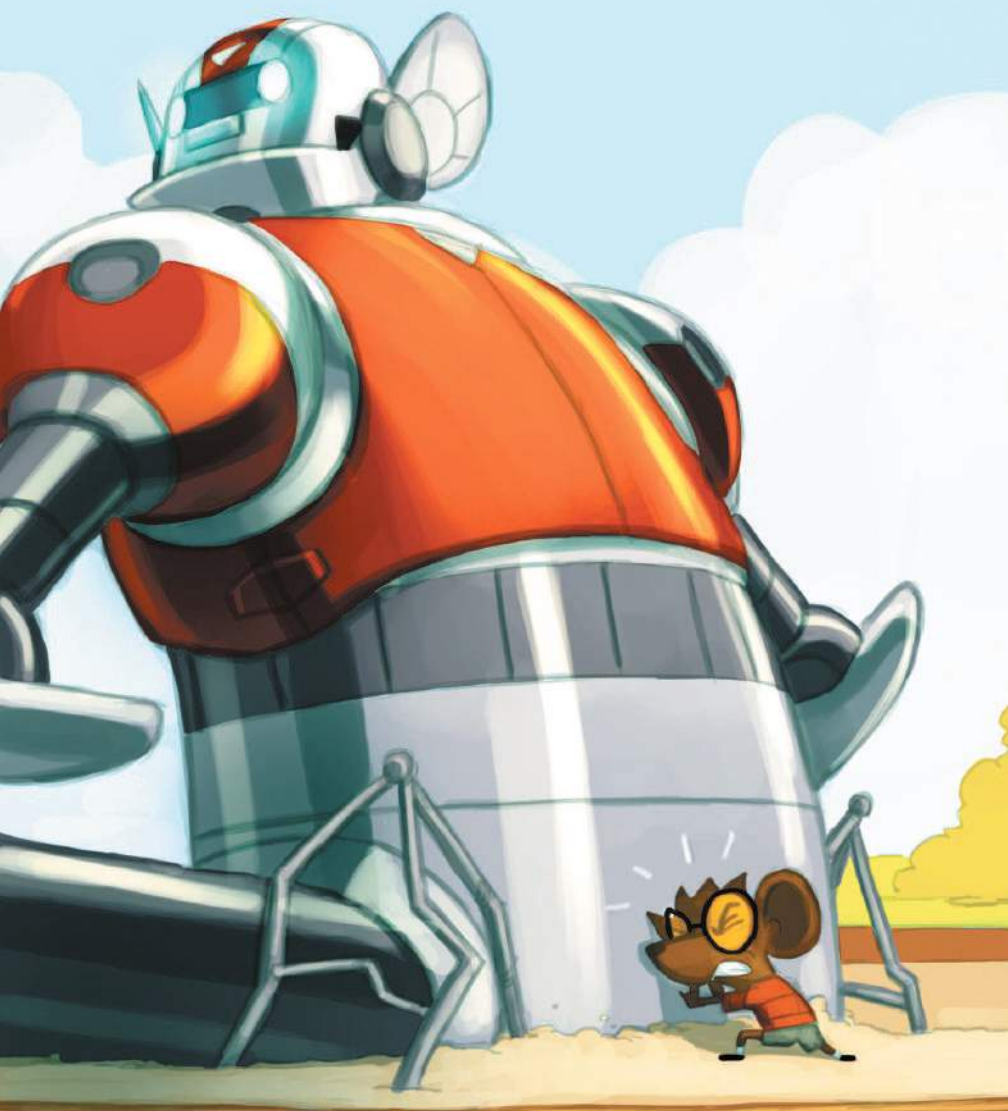


The Mighty Robot pushed Ricky

on the swing set.

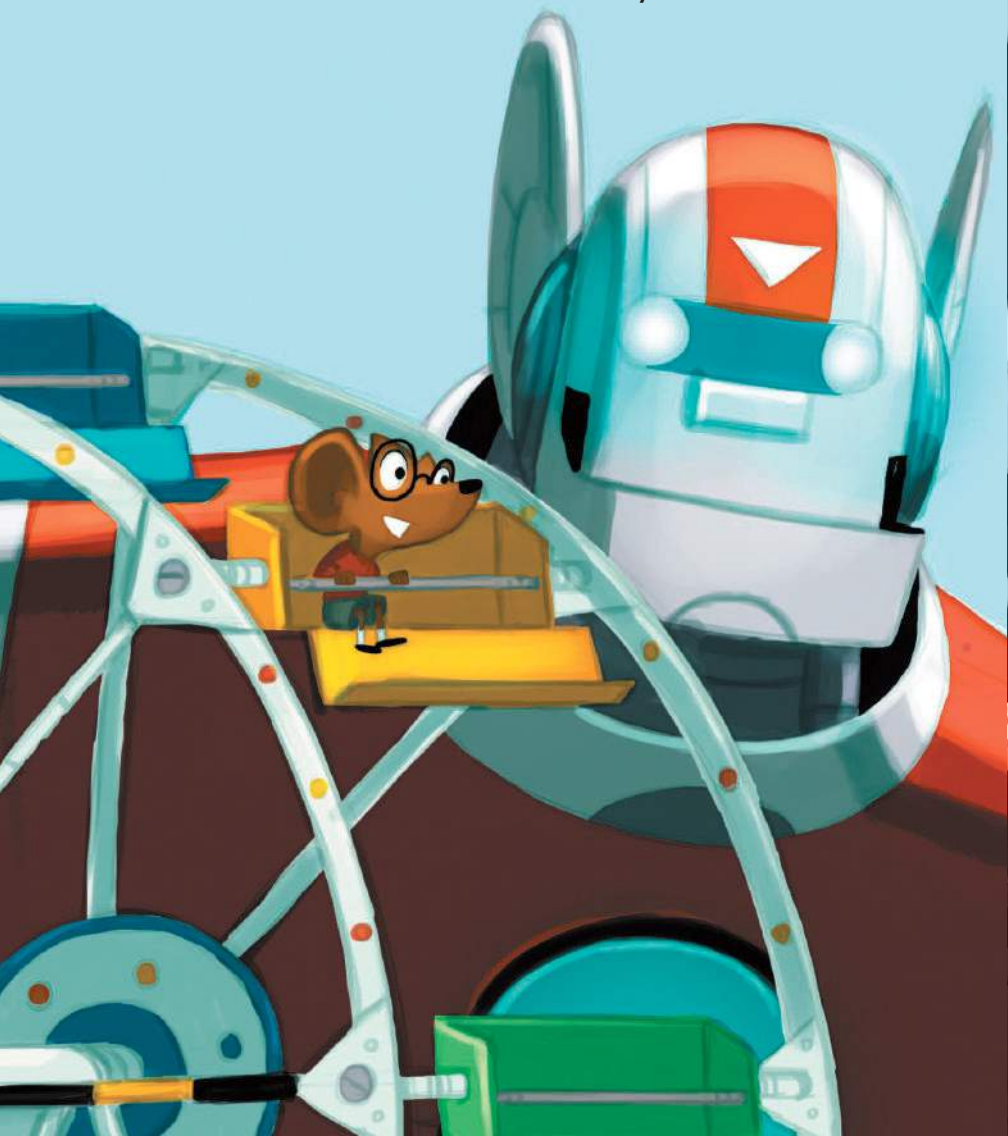
“This is not fun,” said Ricky.

"This is not fun," said Ricky.



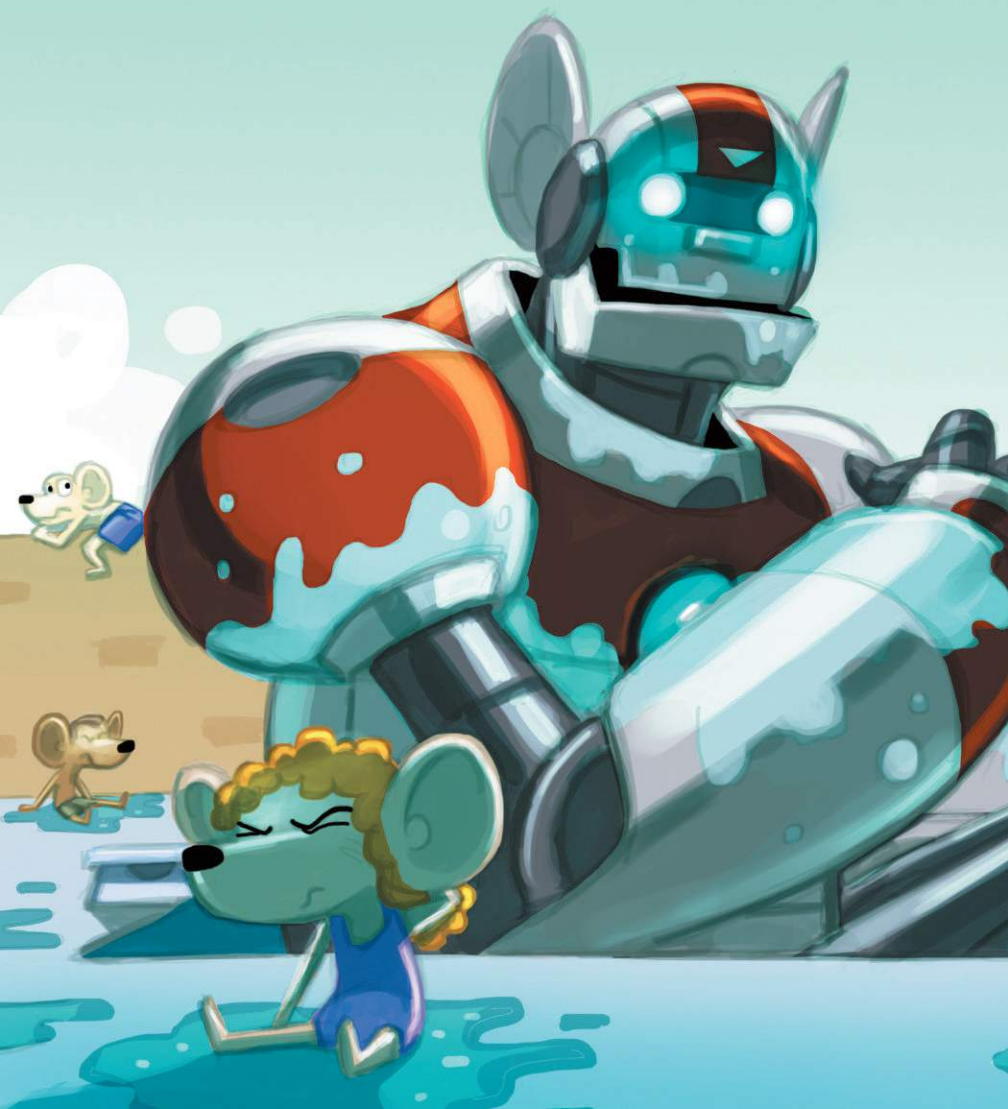
Finally, Ricky and his Mighty
